Art. 1 - Announcement

COINOR - University of Naples Federico II is pleased to invite applicants for its foreign students scholarship program. Scholarships’ recipients must enrol at the first year of one of the international Degree Courses offered by UNINA for the a.y. 2020/2021. Selection is for a total of **24 (twenty-four) max 2-year scholarships**, for the following international Bachelor or Master Degree Courses:

Foreign students enrolled in the first year of the Bachelor Degree Course in *Hospitality Management*, of a Master Degree Course entirely taught in English or of a Double/Triple Degree Course at Federico II University will benefit from a two-year scholarship. Foreign students enrolled in a Double/Triple Degree Course at the corresponding partner University will benefit from a max one-year scholarship for the period of study at Federico II only if not sufficiently financially supported by his/her University of origin.

Application deadline is April 24th, 2020 at 1.00 pm (Italian Time).

Please note that:

1. **having a scholarship assigned does not mean that the recipient is automatically admitted to the degree course of his/her choice. More specifically, scholarship's recipients must follow, in any case, the admission procedures of the chosen degree course.**
2. **scholarships cannot be combined with other prizes or awards granted by Federico II University.**

Art. 2 - Requirements for application

1. High school certificate (for Bachelor Degree in *Hospitality Management* or Master Degree Course in *Medicine and Surgery*) or Bachelor degree certificate (for 2-year Master Degree Courses) or equivalent, issued abroad.
2. Certified English knowledge corresponding to at least B2 level under the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) for **Degree Courses taught entirely o partially in English**. Native English speakers are exempted.
3. Certified Italian and teaching language of the Degree course chosen (French or Spanish) knowledge corresponding to at least B1 level under the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) **only for Double/Triple Degree Course applicants**. Native Italian/French/Spanish speakers are exempted.

Art. 3 - Submission of application

The applications must be sent to admissions@unina.it - enclosing the following documents in **one single *.pdf file**:

1. **Application form** (see Annex 1);
2. **High school certificate** (for Bachelor Degree in *Hospitality Management* or Master Degree Course in *Medicine and Surgery*) **or Bachelor degree certificate** (for 2-year Master Degree Courses) issued by the competent office, translated into Italian (only if not issued by School/University directly in English, French, German or Spanish);
3. **Bachelor degree Transcript of Records** issued abroad containing the list of the exams and their grades. In case the degree certificate is written in a language different from Italian, English, French or Spanish, it is strictly required to add the official translation of the degree certificate in one of the languages mentioned above, together with a legal declaration of local value by the Italian Embassy in the country where the degree certificate was obtained or the **Diploma Supplement (DS)** (only for EU citizens) issued by a competent office in English language;
4. **Declaration of Value (DoV)** (only for non-EU citizen or for EU citizen who cannot provide DS) issued by the Italian Diplomatic Representative, related to the Bachelor degree, if available. This document states the validity of the degree and its correspondence to a first cycle degree and allows to pursue studies in the second cycle. The Declaration of Value is issued by the Italian Diplomatic Representative in the country the educational system of your undergraduate diploma refers to;
5. **CV and job experiences portfolio**;
6. **Motivational letter** (one page, no more than 2.000 characters);
7. **Official English language certificate** (Cambridge ESOL, PET/FCE, IELTS, ETS, TOEFL, etc.) released by an internationally recognized language institution, referring to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (**only for Degree Courses taught entirely o partially in English**);

8. **Official Italian language certificate or teaching languages certificate of the degree course chosen certificate** released by an internationally recognized language institution, referring to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages; **(only for Double/Triple Degree Courses applicants)**.
9. **Passport scan**;
10. Any other **document** deemed useful to the selection.

Art. 4 - Selection Committee

The Selection Committee will be formed by Federico II Internationalization Committee (CIA) members integrated by the degree course Coordinators (or their delegates) for which applications have been submitted, and a “Compagnia di San Paolo” representative.

Art. 5 - Assessment of qualifications

The selection is made on the basis of the following award criteria which will be individually assessed and given a score:

1. **Career** (cv, certificates, portfolio): up to 15 points;
2. **Motivation letter**: up to 8 points;
3. **Official Language Certification**: up to 7 points.

Art. 6 - Publication of the selection list

Candidates will be ranked according to their total score. The list of the candidates with their scores will be published www.unina.it , www.coinor.unina.it and on each degree course websites from **May 29th, 2020**. This posting will represent official notification to the candidates.

If two candidates result having the same total score, the younger one will precede in the list.

Art. 7 - Scholarship and tuition fees

The scholarship amounts to **€ 2.764,98 per semester (€ 5.529,96 per year)**. **Tuition fees need to be paid separately.**

For each year, payment will be made as follows:

- 50% (Euros 2.764,98) at the beginning of the first semester;
- 30% at the beginning of the second semester;
- 20% at the end of the year.

Due tuition fees and taxes (accident insurance include) are:

- € 140,00 for regional tax plus € 16,00 for stamp (marca da bollo), in case of extra EU citizens;
- € 200,00 for registration fee, € 140,00 for regional tax plus € 16,00 for stamp (marca da bollo), in case of EU citizens.

All fellow awardees are responsible for their own travel and health care provisions arrangements. They will receive assistance to find suitable accommodation in Naples and with all bureaucratic procedures (request of permit of stay, bank account opening, etc.) by the service provided by the University of Naples Federico II through the International Students Union (<http://www.unina.it/unina-international/student-mobility/erasmus#Accomodation>).

Art. 8 - What to do once selected

Selected candidates must send to admissions@unina.it within 10 days after candidates' merit list publication:

1. acceptance letter (annex 2); if a candidate does not submit the acceptance letter within 10 days from the date of the publication of the final results of the competition, scholarship will be assigned to the candidate who follows in the ranking list;
2. diploma/degree recognition request (annex 3) properly filled.

Please consider that Transcript of Records and Declaration of Value must be duly apostilled (only if the country where the diploma has been achieved is part of The Hague Convention abolishing requirement for legalization of foreign public documents). Apostilles authenticate the seals and signatures of officials on public documents, so that they can be recognized in foreign countries that are parties of the Convention. Check authorities in charge to: <https://www.hcch.net/en/instruments/conventions/authorities1/?cid=41>. If your country is not part of the list, Transcript of Records and Declaration of Value must be legalized by the Italian Diplomatic representatives.

In case of missing documents, the admission will be rejected

Attention: admitted students MUST PERSONALLY contact the Italian Diplomatic Representatives to get the Entry Visa.

Art. 9 - What to do to receive the scholarship

After the enrollment, a contract needs to be signed to Coinor Office (located in Corso Umberto I, 40 – Naples – II Floor).

To do this, students must bring:

- enrollment certificate (complete of registration number);
- fiscal code (codice fiscale)
- bank account details (IBAN number, swift code, etc.)
- passport copy.
